 So i'm **[G]** going downtown just to **[F]** tie one **[C]** on
 I'm oak aged and **[Am]** sour, I'm goin' **[F]** down by the **[C]** hour
 and I'm **[Am]** as blue as the **[G]** night is **[C]** long.

Won't **[F]** someone dance **[C]** with me to a **[Dm]** waltz about **[C]** whiskey
 And **[Am]** turn my sad **[F]** songs to **[G]** lullabies **[G]** ->
 I don't **[Am]** need much of **[C]** nothin' except for **[Am]** all your **[C]** lovin'
 And a **[Am]** waltz about **[G]** whiskey on **[C]** ice

One **[C]** quarter should **[Am]** do, number **[F]** A thirty-**[C]**two
